

**ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION**  
**WEDNESDAY NIGHT MIXED DART LEAGUE**

**HELD ON WEDNESDAY APRIL 24, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 6:45 pm by the President Moe Dwyer.

Moe Dwyer thanked everyone for attending and noted this would be the election of new officers for the Wednesday Night Mixed Dart League for 2019/20 season, as per the league's Constitution and By-Laws and she would be stepping down from the position at the end of the 2018/19 season.

**DISCUSSION:**

A discussion concerning some of the areas within the Constitution and By-Laws. The placement of "the ghost" during play and when the "ghost" score no longer applies within the game.

Harley Beauregard motioned "the ghost" should hold the 3<sup>rd</sup> spot throughout all the games and play as if it is an actual player in the "C" position. Brian Corbett seconded the motion. **Motion Carried.**

Frank Tinning motioned to change the "ghost" score from 26 to 30, whereas that would assist with the subtraction factor when recording scores. Georgina George seconded the motion. **Motion Defeated.**

Moe Dwyer suggested changing the double "1" ruling when both teams are tied for the game, from the number of rotations of "3" complete rotations to "1" complete rotation. Each player after the "first" complete rotation would be then throw all "3" darts without penalty until a dart strikes the double "1" to achieve a win. This would help with moving onto the next game, and would eliminate the lagging and frustration of play/players. Therefore changing the number of rotation throws for each player regarding the double "1" dilemma shall be "1" complete rotation, then all "3" players' darts would be thrown and the first successful double "1" thrown, would win the game. **All agreed changing to "1" complete rotation before all "3" darts can be thrown to determine which team wins the game.**

Rob Eitzen commented regarding continuing the current play-off format of the season or eliminating it by providing more rounds of season play. 11 were in favour of keeping the play-offs as is; 10 were against having play-offs and 7 were unsure. **Majority were in favour of keeping the play-offs.**

Elections for new offices for 2019/2020 season were held with the following results:

President nominations - Brian Corbett and Brad LeBlanc were both nominated. Brad declined the nomination; Brian Corbett accepted the nomination.

Vice-President nominations - Trevor Craft was nominated - no other nominations came forward.

Treasurer nominations - Sue Graham was nominated - no other nominations came forward.

Secretary nominations – The President asked if the elected Treasurer would also perform the duty as Secretary. Sue Graham agreed to take this responsibility in conjunction with the Treasurer position.

Statistician nominations – Rob Eitzen was nominated – no other nominations came forward.

Spares Captain nominations – Stacey LeDrew, Moe Dwyer and Troy Beauregard. Troy declined the nomination. A vote was taken by a show of hands with the standing nominees out of the area. Moe Dwyer was elected as the Spares Captain for 2019/2020 dart season.

Ways and Means Committee nominations – Laura Corbett and Amber Keller were nominated. Both accepted the nomination and will jointly work together on this committee which can be time consuming at times.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm.
